Regardlessofcause, the activation of the building's fire alarmsystem is an indication of an emergency and immediate and orderly evacuation of the building is essential. Upon discovering fire or smoke, remain calm. The following steps should be carried out in order, if it is a fet odoso, and time permits:

- 1. Upon discoveryofafire, shout "FIRE" toalert those in your living space.
- 2. Ifindoubt,getout!DONOT FIGHTTHEFIRE.Asyouexit thearea,closealldoorsinthe immediatevicinitytohelpconfine thefireintheoriginareaifpossible.
- 3. Checkyourdoorbeforeopeningitto makesureitisnoth otandthefireis notontheotherside.Ifyou encountersmokewhenleavingthe building,stayaslowtotheflooras possible.
- 4. Soundthealarm.Ifyourbuildingis equippedwithfirealarmpull stations,pullthehandleinthefire alarmboxclosetto thelocationof thefire.
- 5. Dial911orreportthefirebycalling theEmergencyNumberofyourlocal firedepartment.Thisnumbershould beattachedtoeveryphoneinyour building.
- 6. If the building is not equipped with fire a larm pull station, try to not i fy as many persons in the area of the emergency if it is safe for you to do so. A taminimum, shout "FIRE" as you exit.
- Individualshearingthewarningor seeingthefireshouldbeginan orderlyevacuationoftheapartment buildingusingsafemeansofexi t.

- 8. If you be come trapped in your room, hangsomething outside the window such as a sheet, curtain, etc., towarn fire fighters you are still in the building. Place we to wels around the top, sides and bottom of your apartment or room door.
- 9. Closeanyremai ningdoorsif possible.Thiswillhelptoreducethe movementofairtominimizethe fire'sspread.
- 10. If your building hall way is equipped with firese paration doors, makes ure they are never blocked to ensure their closure.
- 11. If your building is equipped wit h elevators, DONOT attempt to use them during a fire or fire emergency.
- 12. Whenallpersonshaveevacuatedthe building,theymustremainoutside andatasafeandcleardistanceaway fromthebuilding.Haveacentral meetingplacewhereeveryonein yourde signatedgrouptogatherand beaccountedfor.Ifallcannotbe accountedfor,DONOTRE -ENTER THEBUILDING.Immediately notifyfirefightingpersonnelonthe scene.
- 13. Regardlessofcause,theactivationof thebuilding'sfirealarmsystemisan indication of an emergency and immediate and orderly evacuation of thebuilding is essential.
