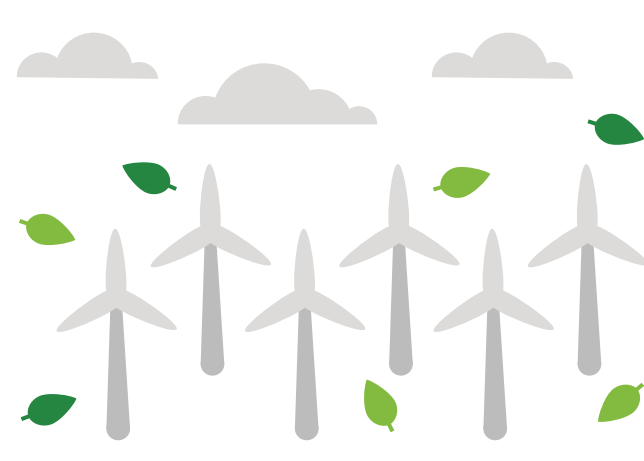
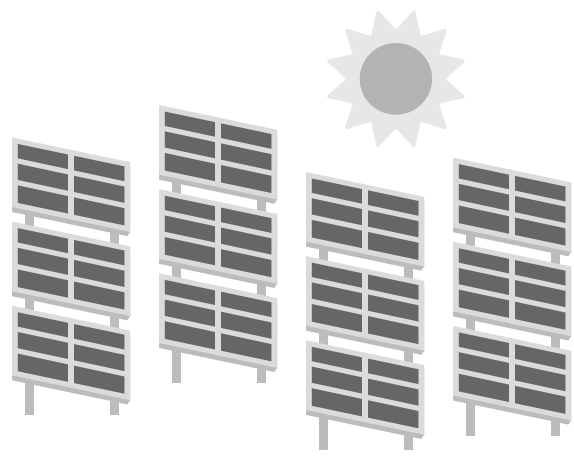

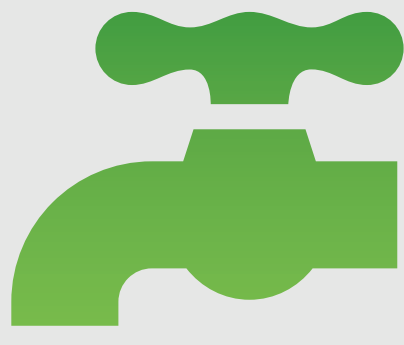

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- Set computers to energy-saving settings and make sure to shut them down when you leave for the day.
- Furnish your workspace with furniture made from recycled materials.
- Find a plant for your workspace, plants absorb indoor air pollution and increase the flow of oxygen.
- Walk or bike to work. This saves on gas and improves cardiovascular health.
- Consider getting a hybrid or carpooling to work.
- Use a water filter to purify tap water instead of buying bottled water, which generates large amounts of container waste.
